A Summary of Your Rights under the Nevada Privacy Law

This is a summary of the rights of Nevada residents under the Nevada Privacy Law (“NPL”) and how they can be exercised with LexisNexis Risk Solutions Inc. and the LexisNexis Risk Solutions companies in scope of the CPA.

As a Nevada resident, you have the Right to Opt-Out of the sale of your personal information, subject to certain exemptions. If you have previously opted-out but instead want to authorize your personal information to be sold, you may submit an opt-in request. These rights may be exercised with us as follows:

Submit a Request Online

As a Nevada resident you can submit an opt-out or opt-in request pursuant to the Nevada Privacy Law online using our Online Request Form. Online requests can be made at:

Request by U.S. Mail

As a Nevada resident you can submit a request for opt-out or opt-in via U.S. Mail by using our Printable Request Form. The Printable Request Form is available at: <https://consumer.risk.lexisnexis.com/privacy>.

Request by Phone

As a Nevada resident you can request an opt-out or opt-in pursuant to the Nevada Privacy Law via phone at 1-888-217-1591.

Information Required for Verification

To submit an opt-out or opt-in request, you are required to provide your First Name, Last Name, Street Address, City, Zip, and Date of Birth. The information that you provide will only be used by us to verify your identity and for processing your request. It will not be provided or sold to any other company. We may not be able to comply with your request if we are unable to confirm your identity or to connect the information you submit in your request with personal information in our possession.

Your Social Security Number or your Driver's License Number and State are not required to submit an opt-out or opt-in request.

Authorized Agent

You may designate an authorized agent to make a request on your behalf subject to proof of identity and written authorization.

Exempt Information

Please note that requests to not sell your personal information will not apply to data exempt from the requirements of the NPL. Specifically, publicly available data is exempt from the requirements of the NPL. The NPL also exempts certain data that is subject to the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA), the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA), the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA), the Driver's Privacy Protection Act (DPPA) and certain other laws.

As a Nevada resident, you have the Right to Opt-Out of your personal information, subject to certain exemptions.

Right to Opt-Out of Sale of Personal Information

You have the right to request that your personal information not be sold, also referred to as the right to "Opt-Out." This will prevent us from selling your personal information that is subject to the requirements of the NPL and to also refrain from doing so in the future.

We will process the request online, by phone, or through U.S. Mail depending on how you have elected to submit the request. We will typically process your opt-out request within two weeks of receipt of the request.

Opt-In

After you have opted out, you also have the option to reauthorize your personal information to be sold. This is referred to as the ability to "Opt-In." If you have previously opted out but instead want to authorize your personal information to be sold, you may submit an "Opt-In" request.
